## Winter Party Summary

## Theme - Polar Express / Winter

Students will be dressed in pajamas
Food - Twinkie train ( directions on website)
Pretzels
Goldfish
Juice Boxes
Crafts - Decorate Bags ( gift bag size with stickers, stamps, etc each class will get own decorating supplies Students can put all items made from party in the bag)

Foam Snowflake Photo Frame Magnet Craft (from Oriental Trade) (Cheryl will order these for everyone)

Game - Frosty Game ( Each class will get own supplies for this game)
Divide kids into 4-5 teams. For each team give them a bag of supplies

1. roll of toilet paper
2. top hat ( from party store)
3. red crepe paper (for scarf)
4. orange construction paper ( for nose)
5. black construction paper ( for eyes \& mouth)
6. scissors
7. tape
8. pencil

Teams will be given 5-10 minutes to create a snowman using one of their teammates. They as a team on their own must figure out how to create a snowman using their teammate and the supplies in the bag.

Prizes ( such as a candy cane) are given for cutest, most creative, etc. Each team will be a winner in some category. Teachers will be judges

Party Favor - Each homeroom parent will be responsible for making the Candy Cane Pencil character craft (Cheryl will order for everyone from Oriental Trade) ( This is on the website) These will be put at the students desk the morning of the party.

Class homeroom parents will make each student a bell necklace. ( Cheryl has the supplies for this)

Polar Express Worksheet Pack - (mazes, word search, color page, etc.) These will be an extra activity (just in case there is extra time at the party) Cheryl will post these activities
on the website and each homeroom parent will need to print and copy these worksheets for their class.

Decorations - Cheryl will ask Mrs. Hawkins what if any art work the classes be doing with the Polar Express unit and if any of these could be used as decorations during the party.

Each class will be responsible for getting own table clothes or butcher paper for covering students desks.
